Thanks for sending your comments.

**Comment:** On behalf of the Summit Lake Paiute Council (Council), governing body of the federally-recognized Summit Lake Paiute Tribe Nevada, I would like to ask that officials of the City of Eureka meet with the Council so that we can share with City officials our rights, at all usual and accustomed places in northern Nevada, including the area of the proposed site where the City plans to dump its waste (wet, including mined human waste) so that we may prevent pollution of our water and traditional foods and medicine (which the animals we rely on for subsistence purposes also consume), and any of our cultural resources, including burials and funeral objects. Nevada is not an empty waste land. Traditional Northern Paiute, Western Shoshone and other Native people still use the land and resources that were once ours before the United States stole the land. We do not and would not pollute your water or land. I look forward to discussing this matter in a civil manner. The Council meets every third Saturday of the month but we could hold a special meeting when convenient to both the City and Council.
