- Attended Environmental Managers Meeting in Wells, Nevada, April 31, 2008
 - Traveled March 31, 2008
 - Experienced Wells earthquake aftershock at 6:15am on April 1
 - Outside of Wells, 12 Mile and Raider Warm Water Springs fenced off
 - Warm water temperature now 250 degrees
 - Red ash in water
 - USGS testing for volcanic gases
- Need to Modify Current Year GAP Budget; must stay within \$106,380.00
- Tribe received \$66,000 as fourth year GAP funds, coupled with Year 1 and 2 Unspent money that represents approximately \$53,000 equals total budget of \$113,000. Proposed GAP Budget of \$82,884. Proposed Indirect Budget: \$30,116.
- At 1pm, Thursday, April 24, 2008 (next week), I will participate in Ruby Pipeline Project Meeting (in Winnemucca) by phone from San Francisco. The RTOC meeting ends at 12:30pm that day.
