Daniel,

Here are some of the changes; others will follow this evening in separate emails. I would also like the instructions and or training on how to make simple changes myself.

Change to TITLE:

Change Environmental Department to Environmental Protection Department. If this cannot be done because of space limitations let me know ASAP. In that case, we will leave it as is but I need to know if the change cannot be accomodated.

Changes to HOME page:

Replace both paragraphs with the following:

WELCOME to the web site of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe (SLPT) which focuses on the environmental protection efforts of the Tribe at its reserved lands (the Summit Lake Indian Reservation) but also supplies tribal members and others with other useful information. For example, the Council Members page lets the public know who are the Tribe's Council members and how they may be contacted. The Newsletters/Research page lets tribal members see the most current up-to-date information available. This is a redesigned web site addressing the input and suggestions of tribal members and others. If you would like to give input and suggestions for further changes contact the Environmental Coordinator (see Contact Us section).

All of the Tribe's departments have one goal: protect the Reservation's resources. Originally, the Tribe's Environmental Protection activities funded by a General Assistance Program (GAP) Grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) were placed inside the Natural Resource Department. In early 2008, the Summit Lake Paiute Council created a separate Environmental Protection Department given the differing but sometimes overlapping roles of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Departments. The Natural Resources Department is quite active with a wide array of programs funded through the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), including Section 106 and Section 319 programs, and Public Law 93-638 (Indian Self Determination) contracts. Both Departments assert the Tribe's sovereignty in protecting the environment, natural resources, and public health of the Summit Lake Indian Reservation and the Tribe's traditional territory where tribal members still retain rights to hunt, fish, gather traditional foods and medicine, and conduct spiritual and religious practices.

Changes to Reporting Incidents page:

To report petroleum (oil, diesel, gasoline), chemical (including radiator fluid), radiological, biological and or etiological discharges and or spills on the Summit Lake Reservation **NO MATTER HOW SMALL**— contact: (1) the Environmental Coordinator either by phone (**1-800-335-7978**) or email: ron.johnny@summitlaketribe.org; and, (2) the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency at (800) 424-8802. Be prepared to give the time, date, substance, and location of the spill or other environmental incident, and the estimated amount spilled (for example, one cup, one quart, five gallons, etc.). It is critical, in sustaining all the resources of the Reservation (Lake, LCT (Lahontan cutthroat trout), sage grouse, deer, antelope, etc.), that all spills and or discharges be reported as quickly as possible.

Changes to Lahontan Cutthroat Trout page:

Change title to make "c" in cutthroat and "t" in trout lower case letters so it reads Lahontan cutthroat trout.

Changes to GAP Grant Documents page:

Add the attached documents: 121307 approved budget modifications to years 2005, 2006 and 2007.pdf; 1st Qtr Newsletter FY 2007-08.pdf; 2nd Qtr Newsletter FY 2007-08.pdf; and SLPT Environmental News Briefs 02-06-08.pdf
