Dear Mr. Singleton,

By this email, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe requests that Ruby Pipeline, LLC, be advise that they must still comply with all of the California laws that Ms. Sanchez originally told Ruby Pipeline, LLC.

At yesterday's BLM meeting on the Ruby Pipeline Project at the BLM Nevada state office, Ruby Pipeline was clearly told that what is being referred to as the Jungo (Road) Tuscarora Alternative is still an active alternative. See Map (attached). The Jungo Tuscarora Alternative, based on Ruby's own map (the attached), clearly enters Lassen County, California, and enters Modoc County, California, before entering the State of Oregon.

The fact that the Jungo Tuscarora Alternative is still a viable alternative seems to be inconsistent with the statement of Richard Derryberry, Director, Regulatory Affairs Department, Ruby Pipeline LLC, on November 11, 2008, to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, Attention Ms. Kimberly D. Bose, Secretary, which stated:

Description of Information Being Filed

On October 3, 2008, Ms. Katy Sanchez, representing NAHC, filed comments in this proceeding regarding the Ruby Pipeline Project ... In response to the NAHC comments, Ruby contacted Ms. Sanchez via telephone to review the comments on October 24, 2008. In this discussion, Ruby clarified to Ms. Sanchez that no components of the Project would be located in Modoc County, California, or any other locations in California.

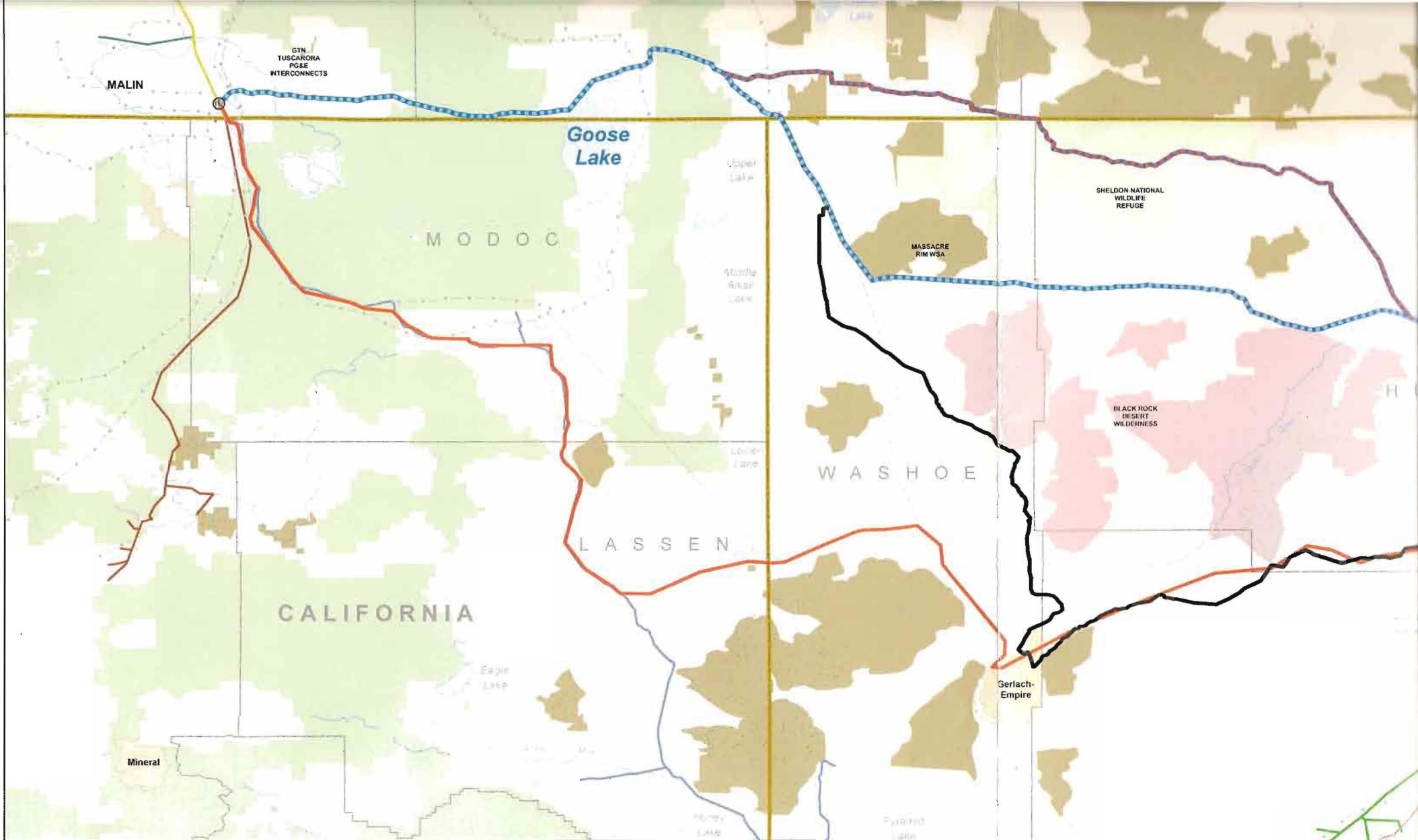
